3. *If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).*
4. *If you pay higher rate tax you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.*
5. *If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for GiftAid tax relief, ask the charity or ask at your local tax office for leaflet IR113 GiftAid.*
6. *Please notify the charity if you change your name or address.*

Thank you for donating to the work of the Red Sea Mission Team. It is very much appreciated and we are very grateful to all our supporters for both their prayers and their gifts. This form draws your attention to a means by which it may be possible to make your gift go a little further towards extending our work.

The British government has introduced a GiftAid Scheme whereby it is possible for RSMT to reclaim tax paid on all gifts from UK taxpayers - large or small, regular or one-off. All that is required is that the donor makes a declaration that their gifts are to be included in the GiftAid scheme. This enables us to reclaim the tax from the tax-man at no extra cost to the donor.

Of course, it may well be that you are not a UK taxpayer, or for other reasons do not wish to use the GiftAid scheme. However, if you are a UK taxpayer, and would like to make a GiftAid Declaration, a form is printed overleaf for you to complete and return to us.

Please let me emphasise that this letter is *not* a request for further donations, nor would making a GiftAid Declaration bind you to making further donations. The Declaration can be cancelled at any time at your request.
